# ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL— EVERY DAY REALLY DOES COUNT

Part of the Department of Education vision, Equity and Excellence, is the strong focus on student attendance at school.

A new report from the Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL) reinforces the strong correlation between school attendance and student achievement, and highlights the importance of forming good attendance habits early.

At Vale View State School, we monitor and reward the class having a greatest attendance each fortnight. In week 10 of Term 1, the Attendance Bear was awarded to the year 5/6 class, who had 95% attendance for the fortnight.

Students are always reminded that sickness is a legitimate reason for being absent, and that they ultimately have no influence in their class's attendance data. What I would like to see is all children wanting to be at school every day, and parents supporting this desire, ensuring that children attend school everyday unless there is a legitimate reason why they can't.

Please also be reminded that parents have a legal obligation in having children at school on every school day, as well as the obligation to advise the school as soon as possible if children are unable to attend school and the reason/s why (e.g. child is sick).

As a principal, I will always welcome discussions with parents regarding improving attendance, and will support families as much as possible in order to have the greatest possible attendance for every student.

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## **PYJAMA DAY**

The last day before the holidays was a fun filled finale to term 1. There were pyjamas, oodies, teddies and lots of laughs. Thanks to our school community, we raised \$97.90. The student cabinet will donate part of this money to The Pyjamas Foundation, which raises money to positively impact children in foster care.
